

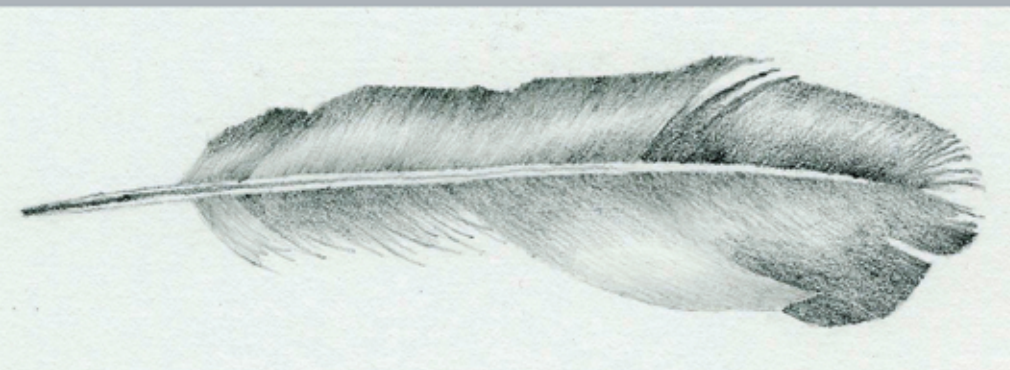


## STEP-BY-STEP DEMONSTRATION

# DERWENT GRAPHIC

There's more to a pencil than just HB

Feather (Finished drawing 6" x 2 1/2")



### MATERIALS USED:

Derwent Graphic pencils used:  
9H, HB and 3B

White cartridge paper 125lbs

## INTRODUCTION

High quality graphite pencils are available in 20 versatile degrees from a soft, smudgy 9B to a crisp, non-scratchy 9H. Ideal for all types of drawing work, from finely detailed line illustrations to soft, subtle sketches.

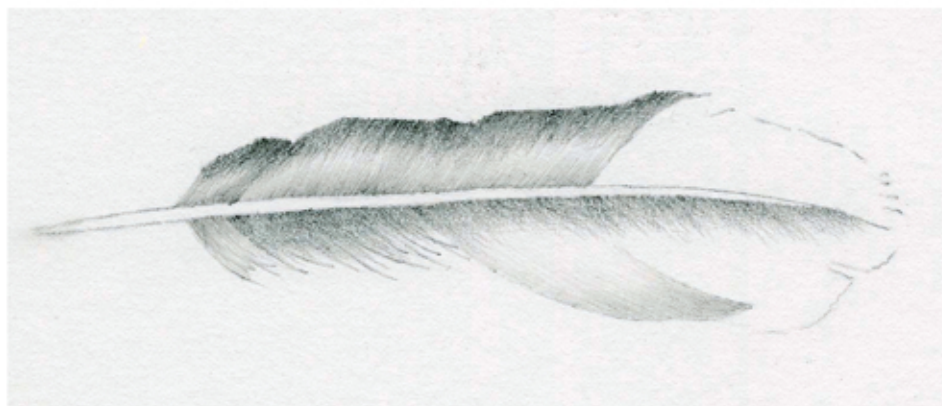
**1** Using the Graphic HB pencil transfer the line drawing.



**2** Begin by using the 9H and start in the centre, press firmly but not 'hard' and stroke the pencil towards the outside. Continue all the way up till the feather splits. Then proceed with the outside top right working in the same way but stroking towards the centre.

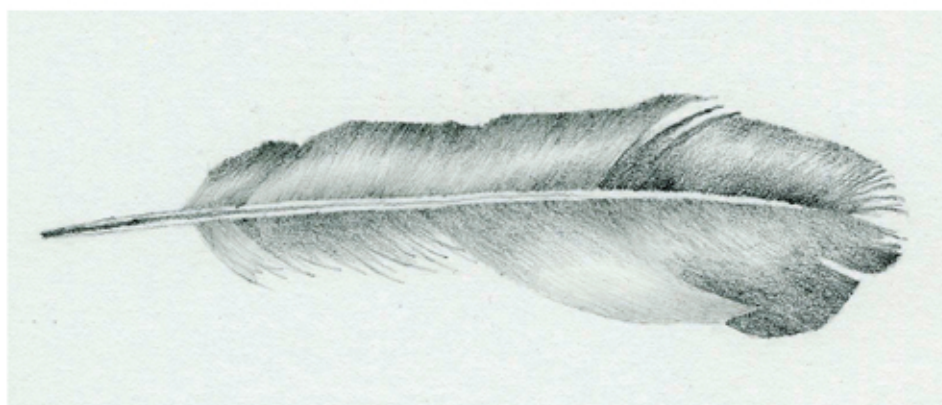
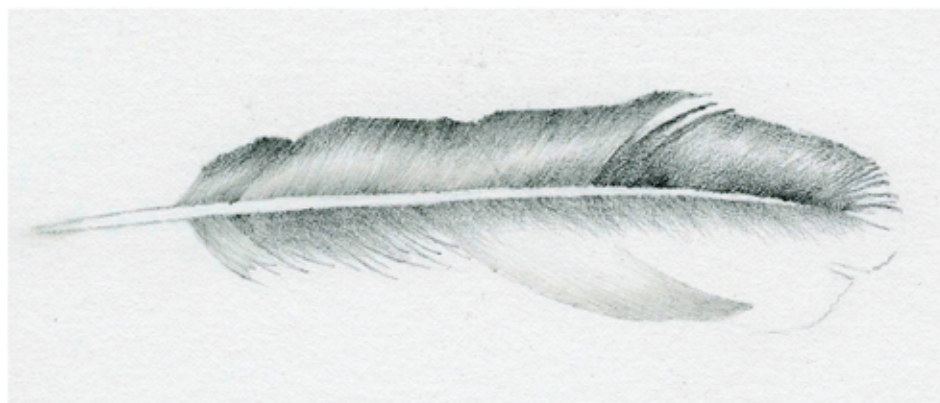

**3** Using HB and pressing very lightly (the tone will automatically be darker) Begin at the centre and stroke outward all the way to the top.

**4** Now using 3B begin above the left side split from the centre outwards to graduate the tone naturally.



**5** Using 3B shade the top right section from the outside toward the centre avoiding the overlap section.

Finally using HB begin at the bottom of the quill and lightly draw the centre line tapering at about 2/3 of the way up.
